Our Year 4/5 students will return home tired this evening after their busy three days at the Bridge Valley Adventure Centre. Our Year 3 students also had a taster of camp on Thursday. The weather played its part and the students have enjoyed a range of activities. Well done Maia for your organisation and a very big thank you to our supporting parents.

Each year we provide an opportunity for whānau feedback to the school via surveys and the Board of Trustees parent forum. Information from these data collection points, as well as direction from the Motueka Kāhui Ako are used to formulate our Strategic Education Plan. The goals on this document are the focus areas of improvement. This generates extra tasks beyond the day to day running of the school. Schools are reviewed on a regular cycle with ERO (Education Review Office). ERO selects one of our goals for deeper analysis. As a school we've had consistently high student achievement data in reading, writing and mathematics for close to ten years, therefore ERO has chosen to focus closely on our goals around cultural competency. A copy of the Tasman School Strategic Education Plan has been emailed home to you. The school's progress against the annual implementation plan is reported to the Board of Trustees on a monthly basis and the Board is responsible for ensuring that we continue to move forward with this plan.

Muddy Buddy is fast approaching. Please take the time to complete the sign up sheet at reception. This is an excellent fundraiser for our school, but also a chance to be part of the community and build strong bonds with other parents. Our Tasman School Fundraising Association does a superb job of running this event as well as organising other school events to bring everyone together. 
SCHOOL LIBRARY
