## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Kia ora koutou.

It is hard to believe that so much devastation has occurred in the North Island, when we've barely seen a sign of the bad weather in our region. Thank you for your support of our Cyclone Gabrielle appeal. A big thank you to Pak n Save Richmond for making a financial contribution of \$100 to the grocery costs, Connings for donating \$40 of vegetable items and other parental contributions. Our efforts have raised \$394.00 which includes monetary donations.

Please have a glance over the dates in the newsletter. We've added a number of events this week. These include:

- An early school closure due to NZEI paid union meetings for teachers
- The school triathlon in preparation for the Weetbix Tryathlon
- A Junior Fun Day for Year 0 3 at Mahana School

- A Ministry of Education approved teacher only day at the start of Term 2

The Tasman School Fundraising Association has worked with the Board to contribute funds to support the cost of our camps and day trips this year. This is in response to the rising living costs that are likely to be impacting many of us. Throughout the year there will be a spread of contributions across all year levels. First up, we have the Year 4 and Year 5 camp. A \$25 contribution will be made per child to reduce the cost of the upcoming overnight camp at Bridge Valley.

We've included some images of our library renovation and upgrade. There are some things to be finalised, but this is the general concept that allows us to meet the Minsitry of Education brief to access the additional funding. Non-fixed furniture is still be added, but the Board has set aside a fund to ensure we are able to purchase suitable shelving that is able to be moved within the space.

As a reminder, please remember to make contact with the school by 9am when your child is absent from school and give a simple explanation of the absence. We need this to provide the appropriate code for Ministry of Education data collection around student attendance. There are three different ways to indicate a student's absence:

- 1. Email the school with three email contacts the classroom teacher, Lisa and myself

- 3. Log the absence using the Skool Loop app

My apologies if you were contacted this week even though you logged an absence. We have corrected a couple of system glitches and this looks like it is now sorted.

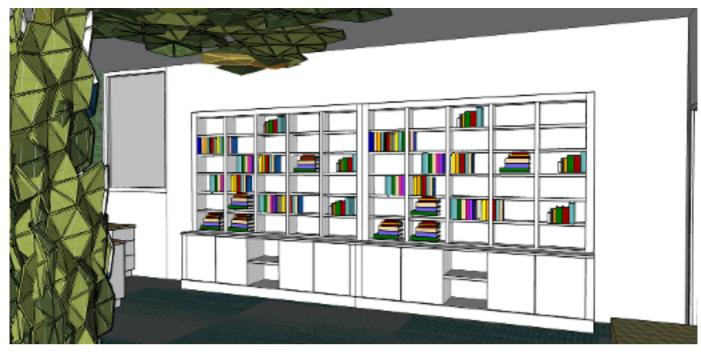

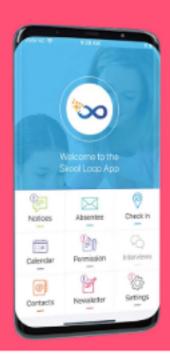

Once you have downloaded the Skool Loop App, via either your Google Play or App store, please follow the below instructions to select your school -

- Open the Skool Loop App you will land on a welcome page.
- Click the 'Select your schools' this will bring you to a menu you can either search your school
  or follow the country/region prompts.
- . Once you reach your school, select it with the tick on the righthand side.
- · Tap the 'select schools' button in the top right corner.
- Tap the big orange choose button. This will load your school and bring you to the settings page.
- Subscribe to the groups that are relevant to you, then click the 'go back' button on your phone, which will bring you to the main screen of your schools app.
