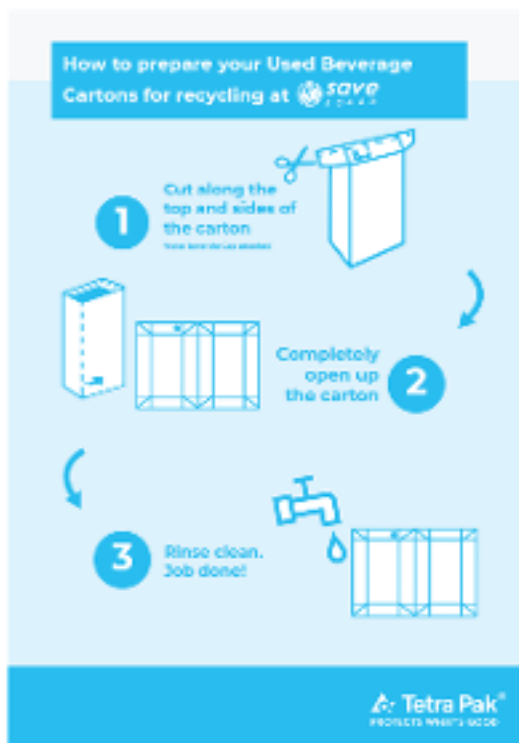


# Tetra paks

We are collecting **tetra paks** for the seniors to bring into MOTEC, as a competition against other schools. Some milks, Campbells stock, and some juices come in tetra paks. A factory in Blenheim is collecting tetra paks to make a building product called save board. This company started up because there was a shortage of Gib board during COVID -19. This is made by milk cartons and juice boxes being sliced up into fine pieces, then melted down and pressed into flat boards. They have a 50% less carbon footprint than normal Gib loo.
